## Class Contract (Kerry Ojakian's CSI 35 Class)

Please read the following policies carefully. Then sign and date the form at the bottom to indicate that you understand all the policies on this sheet.

1. All exams are to be done completely individually by each student with no aid whatsoever from anyone else, and with no aid from any electronic device, i.e. on every single exam in this course, you are not allowed phones, calculators, etc. Using an electronic device during an exam or even simply having it out during an exam will be considered academic dishonesty.
2. Unless explicit instructions by the professor are given to the contrary, the following is the policy on homework.
You may work with other students, however here are the guildines (violating these guildlines will be considered academic dishonesty):
(a) You must hand in your own homework assignment.
(b) You may not work with anyone outside of this class unless you get permission from me.
(c) If you work with someone on a homework, you must put their names on your homework (example: "I worked with Barack Obama and Elizabeth Warren on this homework").
(d) You may not plagarize, i.e. if you use some other source you must reference it precisely. And you may never copy solutions from any sort of solution manual.
(e) You may work with other students, but you may not copy: By this, what is meant is that you may discuss all the ideas together and do calculations together, but then each student writes up their own homework without looking at the writeup of another student. In particular, you must understand what you hand in; I may periodically call students in to my office to double check that you understand what you hand in.
3. Any act of academic dishonesty will have serious consequences, possibly involving the following: i) Having an official report filled with the administration about your academic dishonesty, ii) Automatic failure for the exam, assignment, or entire homework grade, and/or iii) Automatic failure for the entire course.
