Good	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 50-74% are employed as engineering technologists</li> <li>• 40-59% or more have baccalaureate degrees or pursuing additional education</li> <li>• 60-74% are attaining increasing levels of responsibility in their chosen career</li> <li>• All graduates are respectful of cultural diversity and adhere to professional standards</li> </ul>
Satisfactory	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 35-49% are employed as engineering technologists</li> <li>• 25-39% have baccalaureate degrees or pursuing additional education</li> <li>• 40-59% are attaining increasing levels of responsibility in their chosen career</li> <li>• Nearly all graduates are respectful of cultural diversity and adhere to professional standards</li> </ul>
Poor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 35% or less are employed as engineering technologists</li> <li>• Less than 25% have baccalaureate degrees or pursuing additional education</li> <li>• Less than 40% are attaining increasing levels of responsibility in their chosen career</li> <li>• Evidence that some are not respectful of cultural diversity and adhering to professional standards</li> </ul>
